Entry deadline is: Sunday, February 23rd, 2014 AT MIDNIGHT PST

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED up until Tuesday, February 25thth Noon PST and will be subject to a \$20 per race late entry fee. Also, late registrations will not be seeded. Please

Relay team entry deadline is noon, Saturday, March 1st.

LICENCES: All competitors skiing in Juvenile, Junior, Open and Masters categories must have at least one

of the following licences:

• CCC Racing Licence

FIS Licence

Other National Ski Licence

• CCC Supporting Day Member Licence (can be ordered with on-line registration)

Competitors in **MIDGET AND YOUNGER** classes do not need a licence to compete but must be members in good standing of a CCC club. If they are not CCC club members, participants must pay \$5.00 to join the hosting club, Telemark Nordic Club, in order to enter in this competition. Names of new club members will be registered with CCBC to meet the insurance requirements.

SEEDING:

Competitors in the Senior Men and Junior Men categories and those in the Senior Women and Junior Women will be combined for seeding purposes and will compete as a single Open competition. The categories will be separated into Open and Junior for results and awards/prizes. The current Canada Points List (CPL) for both distance and sprint competitions will be used.

There will be no seeding for categories that do not require a racing licence (e.g., Midgets). Order of start will be by random draw.

REFUNDS:

Refunds will only be issued for those competitors who withdraw from the race prior to the race entry deadline of February 24th at midnight.

RELAY:

Each relay team is comprised of 3 skiers. There are only 8 relay categories:

Pee Wee Boys: Atoms and Pee Wees (Age 9 & under)
Pee Wee Girls: Atoms and Pee Wee (Age 9 & under)
Midget Boys: Bantams and Midgets (Age 10 to 13)
Midget Girls: Bantams and Midgets (Age 10 to 13)
Junior Men: Juveniles and Juniors (Ages 14 to 19)
Junior Women: Juveniles and Juniors (Ages 14 to 19)

Open Men: Open & Masters Men
Open Women: Open & Masters Women

Younger skiers may ski on older age category relay team, however, the reverse is not permitted. A Maximum of one female skier may compete on a male relay team.

An Official relay team will have 3 team members from the same club. Club Championship trophy points will not be awarded to unofficial teams.

Relay registration for pre-registered athletes will be open on Monday, February 17^{th} until noon Saturday, March 1^{st} .

Bibs for each day of racing will be distributed from the Race Office upon opening of race office.

AWARDS:

Teck, a diversified resource company based in BC, is the title sponsor of the BC Cup series. Teck provides the awards for ages 14 and under. All Atoms will receive a special Teck participant ribbon. Awards for ages 15 and over will be provided by Telemark. Awards ceremony will occur directly after each day of racing except for Saturday's race where those medals will be awarded at the evening awards ceremony.

Teck BC Cup Series aggregate awards will be presented at the evening awards ceremony. Please see the Technical package for more information on the aggregate awards.

CLUB TROPHY:

The BC Championships is also an annual club competition. Each participating CCBC club accumulates points and the club with the most points is awarded the Club Championship trophy. Points are awarded to the top 5 finishers on Saturday and the top 5 official relay teams on Sunday. See Technical Package for complete details.

AWARDS CEREMONY: The awards for Saturday's individual race and the Teck BC Cup Series aggregate awards will be presented at the evening awards ceremony. Please see the Technical package for more information on the aggregate awards.

The awards ceremony, offering desert and refreshments, is on the Saturday evening at:

Peachland Community Centre

4450 6th Street, Peachland (just south of West Kelowna)

Doors open at 6:30 PM, awards at 7:00PM

The \$10 fee for each racer is included in the race registration fees.

Due to the capacity of the community centre, a limited number of additional tickets for family and coaches will be available at the race office for \$10 on Saturday from 10:30 AM to 2PM.

Directions: from Kelowna or West Kelowna head South on Highway 97 to Peachland. Do not get on off-ramp to the Coquihalla connector. Continue south on Highway 97 for approximately 7.5 km. Turn left onto 13th Street and drive 200 meters and then turn right onto Beach Ave. Drive south along this lakeside route for another 1.1 km and then turn right onto 6th Avenue. The Community Centre is 100 metres along on the right side of 6th Avenue.

The Telemark Junior Race team will also be selling raffle tickets as a team fundraising activity.

CONCESSION: There will be a concession available.

FACILITIES: There is a day lodge at the race site. In addition, one of the machine sheds will be available for

shelter. Portable toilets will be located close to the stadium area.

TRAIL FEES: Trail fees will be waived for all competitors, coaches and assistant coaches on each race day and

> on the official training day, Thursday, February 27th. Passes must be picked-up at the Telemark office and displayed while using the facilities. No pass is required during competition days.

WAX FACILITIES: Outdoor electrical outlets are available on the roadway leading from the parking lot to the

stadium. Waxing is not permitted in the day lodge. Additional power will be made available from the 'old' groomer shed, located nearest to the Telemark chalet, however, it is on a first come, first 'plugged-in' basis. Teams are encouraged to bring portable generators and tents. **WAX TESTING:** NO WAX TESTING ALLOWED on the course. No exceptions. A wax testing area will be

designated.
