LICENSES: No race license is required. Racers must be paid-up members of a Cross-

Country Canada or US Ski Association registered club.

by 9:00 PM on Friday, Jan. 17th (skate distance race) and on Saturday, Feb. 16th

(classic distance relays).

BIB PICKUP: Saturday: 11:30 AM – 12:00 Noon, outside of lodge

AWARDS: Awards for the Saturday and Sunday races will be presented approximately 30

min. after the last racer finishes on each day.
