## Teck Okanagan Cup Nordic Ski Race yielded great local results — UPDATED with photos

The Revelstoke Nordic Ski Club was host to the Teck Okanagan Cup #1 Nordic ski race on Saturday January 2 at the Macpherson Nordic Trails. Although the weather was cold, with temperatures around race time only achieving a high of approximately -12° Celsius, spirits were high and the 252 participants had great ski conditions.

There were 61 Revelstoke residents who participated in this event. This race was also a BC Winter Games Zone 2 Trial. Participation involved six Okanagan-based clubs, plus the Valhalla Hills Nordic Ski Club, Canmore Nordic and two jet-setting skiers from New South Wales, Australia. The event was an interval start classic, with competitors 15 seconds apart and utilizing the diagonal-stride and double-pole techniques.


