ELIGIBILITY: Skiers must be a member in good standing of a CCC/CCBC club.

This race is designed to appeal to racers of all levels, from children and their parents just starting out to advanced racers.

LICENCES: No race license is required

RACE REGISTRATION: Registration and fee payment is ON-LINE only at: Zone4 Registration Credit card payment is required. Check the Zone4 confirmation list for this event (available from the online registration section of Zone4) to be sure that you have registered correctly!

DEADLINE: Entries must be received by Wednesday, **February 26, 2020** at 11:59 p.m. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**

DRAW: Thursday, February 27, 2020, posted at www.zone4.ca

START LISTS: Start lists will be posted on Zone4 and be available Saturday morning after 8:30 a.m. at the bib pickup.

BIB PICKUP: Bib pickup for the race will be at the Nechako Valley Sporting Association Clubhouse 6 km West of Vanderhoof (turn North on Redmond Pit Road and follow the signs) between 9:00 a.m. and 10:15 a.m. on Saturday, February 29, 2020.

Bibs must be picked up by 10:15 a.m.

AWARDS: An awards ceremony will be held on site following the race. In addition to the medals there will be <u>lots</u> of draw prizes to give away!

TEAM AGGREGATE AWARDS:

Club points are accumulated for each skier who successfully completes the race. Cross Country BC will post the aggregate points earned by participating clubs as they accumulate throughout the season. The winner of the Club Aggregate Award will be the club with the most points. As this is the 5th and last race in the TECK Northern Cup the Club Aggregate Award will be presented immediately after the race has been completed!

Top 5 placing in each category	7 (for first place), 6, 5, 4, 3 points				
If there are less than five competitors in a category, the points will still begin at 7 points					
for 1st place, 6 points for 2nd place, etc.					

FACILITIES: A clubhouse with washrooms is located adjacent to the Nechako Valley Sporting Association trails.

PARKING: There is limited parking adjacent to the Nechako Valley Sporting Association clubhouse. Over flow parking is available along Quail Drive (the access road to the Nechako Valley Sporting Association trails).

WAXING: Participants should come to the race with skis already waxed as there are limited power outlets available for waxing.

Cross Country BC respectfully requests all coaches, athletes, wax technicians and parents to abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for athletes in all age categories at all Teck Regional Cup races. This protocol also applies to coaches, athletes, wax technicians and parents traveling to British Columbia from out-of-province or out-of-country.

CCBC Low Fluoro Glide Waxing Protocol:

- Structure tools ARE permitted.
- Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted.
- Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted.
- Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquids) are NOT permitted.
- Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted.

WARM UP/WAX TESTING: A warm up area will be available in the vicinity of the race start.

COURSES: Course maps for all the race categories will be posted outside the clubhouse on race day.

CONCESSION: All racers will be provided with a <u>free hot lunch</u>. For supporters/spectators a food concession will be available at the clubhouse.

CANCELLATION: There are no refunds of any kind once a racer registers and then subsequently withdraws from the race or does not show up for the race. If the organizers are required to cancel the race due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances, then full refunds will be issued with the exception of any online processing fees.
