Draw: Start lists will be posted at the Race Office on race morning.

Bib Pick-Up: Race day, 9:45 a.m. to 10:30 a.m., at the Gary Murdoch Wax Hut.

Awards: Award presentations will take place immediately following the race. Awards for

athletes 15 years and younger will be provided by Teck Resources Ltd. Ribbons and medals will be given to participants aged 15 and younger, as follows: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place medals for age categories 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 - both male and female will be awarded. Ribbons for 4th and 5th place skiers will be provided for the above age categories, as will participant ribbons for all children 7 years of age and younger. Awards for older athletes will be provided by BV Nordic.

Concession: No lunch or concession will be provided at this race.

Waxing:

Due to COVID policy, the Gary Murdoch Memorial Waxing Hut will **not** be available for waxing on the day of the race.

Outdoor electric plug ins will be available for hot irons.

CCBC Protocol Regarding the Use of Fluorinated Waxes

Cross Country BC has adopted a No Fluoro policy for all age categories at all Teck Regional Cup races, please see

CCBC No-fluoro Glide Waxing Protocol

Non-fluoro waxing protocol applies to all ages:

- Structure tools ARE permitted.
- Only identified non-fluoro (NF) glide waxes are permitted
- Fluorinated grip waxes ARE permitted

Trail pass:

Registered racers and coaches will be provided a trail pass for the day of the race at the race bib handout location. Spectators do not require a trail pass to watch the race. If you are not a racer or a coach you will require a day pass to use the trails on the day of the race.

Cancellation:

There will be no refund for participants who choose to not start their race. If race organizers cancel the race(s) due to unsafe weather conditions, a full refund will be made to participants except for any online processing fees. Races will be cancelled or postponed if temperature or weather conditions are unsuitable at start time.

With air temperatures below -20°C (temperature measured at the coldest point of the course and without wind factor) and competition distances less than or equal to 15 km, the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition. For athletes under 12 years of age, with air temperatures below -15C (temperature measured at the coldest part of the course and without a wind factor), the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition.
