**Eligibility: Open to skiers of all ages and abilities!** No race license is required.

> Athletes trying out for the BC Winter Games must be either 13 or 14 years of age as of December 31st, 2023. This means that eligible athletes were born in 2009, or 2010. Athletes may attend only one BC Winter Games. Athletes born in 2010 may compete in the 2009 age Category but athletes born in 2009 must compete in that age category. Once an athlete has chosen which age category they will compete in, they must remain in that category for the duration of the Games. All skiers must compete in their zone trials in order to qualify for the BC Winter Games. For more information please see Cross-Country BC Technical Guidelines.

Para skiers of all ages, welcome.

Para skiers born between 1988 and 2010 are eligible to qualify for BCWG.

Indigenous Participation Program: Up to 8 additional competitors (4 male and 4 female) and 2 additional coaches (1 male and 1 female) with Indigenous ancestry are permitted providing they

self-identify and can produce proof of ancestry.

Registration: Registration is online at <u>Zone 4</u>. Price: \$5.00 / entry, all ages, all categories.

December 29th, 2023 at 12:00 noon Deadline:

**Cancellations:** If the organizers are required to cancel the race due to weather it will be posted on Zone 4, the

club website and the club Facebook feed.

Start Lists and

Start lists will be posted on **Zone4** by Friday at 7 pm (December 29, 2023) and will also be **Results:** available in Raven Lodge the morning of the race. Skiers are not seeded, but grouped by

category and their positions determined by a normal draw procedure.

**Bib Pickup:** At Raven Lodge between 8:30 am and 9:30 am on Saturday December 30, 2023.

Awards: There will be awards to skiers in the stadium near the finish area after all the races have finished.









**Facilities:** 

The Mt Washington Nordic Centre has over 50 km of groomed Nordic ski trails that cover a variety of terrain and land ownership including Strathcona Park. The facility is owned and operated by the Mt Washington Alpine Resort. The Raven Nordic Lodge features day lodge facilities, food services, rentals, retail sales, lockers, sauna and showers and also services a growing snowshoeing base and toboggan area.

Waxing:

Cross Country BC respectfully requests all coaches, athletes, wax technicians, and parents to abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for identified races taking place in British Columbia.

#### **CCBC Waxing Protocol:**

#### **Not Permitted:**

- Fluoro kick wax
- High fluoro (HF), medium fluoro (MF), or low fluoro (LF) glide wax, including HF, MF, or LF powders, pucks, blocks and liquids
- Fluoro cold weather powder additives and hardeners
- Fluoro grip powders

The above <a href="CCBC waxing protocol">CCBC waxing protocol</a> applies to the following races/age categories:

- At local races (i.e., club races, loppets, etc.), the protocol applies to U14 and younger age categories.
- At Regional Cup races (Coast Cup, Okanagan Cup, Kootenay Cup, Northern Cup), the protocol applies to ALL age categories.
- At BC Track Attack Championships, BC Winter Games and BC Winter Games Trials, the protocol applies to ALL age categories.
- At BC Cup races (including the BC Championships) the protocol applies to ALL age categories.

Ski testing on course during warm up must be in direction of travel and is allowed until 5 minutes before the first start. Wax /ski testing/warmup is available on non-race trails throughout the day.

Course:

Course maps will be posted online on the club website <a href="https://strathconanordics.com">https://strathconanordics.com</a> as soon as the courses have been finalized. Course distances/laps may be subject to change.

In the event that snow conditions or weather dictate a change in the course or distance, updates will be posted on the club website.
