BC WINTER GAMES ELIGIBILITY: Athletes trying out for the BC Winter Games must be born in 2010 (U14-2) or 2009 (U16-1) and must be a member in good standing of a Zone 1 club. Athletes born in 2010 may compete in the 2010 or 2009 age categories. Athletes born in 2009 must compete in the 2009 age category.

INDIGENOUS POSITIONS: Up to eight athletes with Indigenous ancestry will be eligible to attend the Games. These spots are in addition to the number of athletes that are permitted to attend the 2024 BC Winter Games. The selection criteria for the Indigenous positions are listed in the BC Winter Games Technical Guidelines.

RACE REGISTRATION: Registration and fee payment is through the [Zone 4 Event page](#). Racers and coaches **must** check the confirmation list on Zone4 as soon as possible after they complete their registration to ensure they are registered in the correct category. Contact the race secretary (RaceSecretaryBJSC@gmail.com) before 9:00 AM PST on Friday, December 29 if corrections are required.

RACE ENTRY DEADLINE: Wednesday, December 27, 11:59 PM PST.

RACE FEES: \$20 per race. GST, Nordiq Canada \$3 fee and Zone4 fees will be in addition to these race fees.

LICENSES: No race license is required. Racers must be current members of a Nordiq Canada club.

LIABILITY WAIVER FORMS: Waivers accepted online via the [Zone 4 registration](#).

START LISTS: Start times for the race will be posted at the race office and [online](#) by 12:00 PM on Friday December 29.

BIB PICKUP: Saturday December 30, 11:30 AM -12:30 PM in the Race Office. The Race Office will be in the grooming shed, adjacent to the trailhead cabin. There will be no bib-pick-up allowed 30 min prior to the start of all races.

AWARDS: No awards.

FOOD & DRINKS: Post-race drinks and a cookie will be offered to racers in the finishing chute.

FACILITIES: There is a heated trailhead cabin available. In addition, there are outhouses located nearby. First aid attendants will be present on site. There are no dogs allowed on the trails, except for the [designated dog trails](#).

WAXING: An open area is available to set up waxing tents to the east of the finish line, near the sea cans. Waxing in the parking lot is also allowed for wax trailers. Limited power is available. (Six duplex outlets).

CCBC RULE REGARDING THE USE OF FLUORINATED WAXES: CCBC has adopted a no-fluoro policy for all competitions held in BC. [For more information click here](#).

COURSE MAPS: Course maps are on the [Black Jack Ski Club website](#) and the [Zone 4 Event page](#). Skiers are responsible for knowing their course prior to the race.

TRAIL PASSES: Race entry fees include full use of trails for the race day only. Trail passes are required for skiing on non-race days and can be [purchased online](#) or at the trailhead kiosk.
