ELIGIBILITY	This race is designed to appeal to racers of all levels, from children and their parents just starting out to advanced racers.				
LICENCES	ALL participants must purchase a \$3.00 Tier 3 Event Licence regardless of whether they hold an FIS Licence, Nordiq Canada Race Licence, Development Licence, or Associate Race Licence. This license will only be valid for the competition day for which it is issued and will automatically be added to all race registrations on Zone4.				
REGISTRATION	Registration is only through <u>Zone4</u> . Please review your confirmation email to ensure accurate registration. Coaches must register through <u>Zone 4</u> . No fees are required.				
DEADLINE	Entry deadline Tuesday, January 16th, 2024 at 11:59 p.m. (midnight) LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.				
TRAIL FEES	All racers must have a Whistler Olympic Park (WOP) trail pass for the day of the race. These are not included in your race registration fee but can be purchased at an event discount fee during race registration. Skiers with a WOP season pass do not need to purchase a day pass but will need it to gain entry to the Park.
