Despite the change, 115 racers came out for races that ranged in distance from 300 metres to 7.5 kilometres, and embraced the challenge with big smiles.





The final race in the Teck Coast Cup Series will take place in Whistler next month, where the Club Aggregate Award for the Series will be presented.
