ELIGIBILITY	This race is designed to appeal to racers of all levels, from children and their parents just starting out to advanced racers.
LICENCES	<p>ALL participants must purchase a \$3.00 Tier 3 Event Licence regardless of whether they hold an FIS Licence, Nordiq Canada Race Licence, Development Licence, or Associate Race Licence.</p> <p>This license will only be valid for the competition day for which it is issued and will automatically be added to all race registrations on Zone4.</p>
REGISTRATION	<p>Participant registration is through Zone4 only. Please review your confirmation email to ensure accurate registration.</p> <p>Coaches must register through Zone 4. No fees are required.</p>
ENTRY DEADLINE	<p>Entry deadline Monday, March 3rd, 2025 at 11:59 p.m. (midnight)</p> <p>LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.</p>
TEAM SIGN UP	Coaches or team organizers should register teams here . Please submit teams no later than Wednesday March 4 th , 11:59 PM.
TRAIL FEES	All racers must have a Whistler Olympic Park (WOP) trail pass for the day of the race. These are not included in your race registration fee but can be purchased at an event discount fee during

	<p>race registration. Skiers with a WOP season pass do not need to purchase a day pass but will need it to gain entry to the Park.</p>	
CANCELLATIONS	<p>Any advance cancellation of the event will be by Cross Country BC in consultation with the organizing committee.</p> <p>A decision to cancel the competition, or races for a specific age category due to the race conditions during an event will be made by the Chief of Competition in consultation with the race organizers.</p>	
REFUNDS	<p>In the occurrence of cancellation by race organizer, a refund of registration fees less administration and event expenses already incurred will be provided post-event. No refunds will be made if an athlete does not participate in the race. Zone4 online booking fees are non-refundable.</p>

START LISTS	<p>Start lists will be posted on Saturday morning March 8th, 2025 outside the race office and on Zone4.</p>	
BIB PICKUP	<p>Individual bib pick-up will be in the Stadium at the entrance to the start area. Athletes should collect their bib 15-30 minutes prior to start time. Bibs not picked up will be marked DNS. There are no timing chips for this race.</p>	
WAX POLICY	<p><i>Cross Country BC has adopted a No Fluoro policy for all age categories at all Teck Regional Cup races, please see CCBC Rule Regarding Use of Fluorinated Waxes.</i></p>	
WARM UP	<p>A warm up area will be available in the vicinity of the race start.</p>	
WAXING	<p>Waxing trailers are available for rent at Whistler Olympic Park at a rate of \$50.00 per day. Please contact the Race Office for wax cabin requests.</p>
