ATHLETE REGISTRATION:

Registration is through Zone4. Racers and coaches must check the confirmation

list on Zone4 to ensure participants are in the correct categories.

Email RaceSecretaryBJSC@gmail.com by 9:00 AM on Friday, March 7 if

corrections are required.

COACH REGISTRATION: <u>Coaches are required to register on Zone4</u>. There is no fee for coach registration.

DEADLINE: Registration closes Wednesday, March 5, 2025 at 11:59 PM (PST).

LICENSES: All participants except U6 (Bunnies) must purchase a Nordig Canada Tier 3 Event

Day License. The license is only valid for the competition day for which it is issued

and will be automatically added to registrations on Zone4.

START LISTS: Start lists will be at the Race Office and online. Lists for Saturday events will be

posted on Friday March 7. Lists for Sunday events will be posted on Saturday

March 8.

RACE OFFICE: The Race Office is in the grooming shed, adjacent to the trailhead cabin.

BIB & CHIP PICKUP:

Saturday bib pickup: 9:30 AM -10:30 AM in the Race Office Sunday bib pickup: 8:00 AM - 9:00 AM, in the Race Office

Chip pickup: 15 minutes before start time, by the Timing Hut in Upper Stadium

No bib pickup within 30 minutes of the start of races.

Kootenay Cup Teams are asked to designate one person to pick up all bibs.

A \$100 replacement fee is charged to any skier not returning their bib or chip.

TECK KOOTENAY U6 and U8 – Participant ribbons

CUP AWARDS: U10 to U16 – Teck Medals for top three finishers, Teck Ribbons for 4th and 5th

U18 and up – Local Medals

Awards for U10 athletes will be presented as soon as results are available. Awards for all other age groups in the Teck Kootenay Cup will be approximately

30 minutes after the final racer has finished.

FACILITIES: A heated trailhead cabin is available with outhouses located nearby. A first aid

attendant will be on site. There are no dogs allowed on the trails, except for

the designated dog trails.

FOOD & DRINKS: Gatorade and cookies will be offered to racers in the finishing chute.

WAXING: Waxing tents can be set up to the east of the finish line, near the sea cans.

Limited power is available (six duplex outlets). Teams are encouraged to

bring portable generators and tents.

CONDITIONS:

COURSE MAPS: Course maps will be on the Black Jack Ski Club event website and the Zone4

Event page. Skiers are responsible for knowing their course prior to the race.

TRAIL PASSES: Race entry fees include full use of trails for the race day only. Trail passes are

required for skiing on non-race days and can be purchased online or at the

trailhead kiosk.

ACCOMMODATION: Red Mountain Resort Lodging is offering a 30% discount for March bookings
