Teck Coast Cup #2 and BC Winter Games Trials (Zones 3, 4, 5)

Vancouver, BC – Hollyburn Cross Country Ski Club hosted the Teck Coast Cup #2 and BC Winter Games Trials (for zones 3, 4 & 5) at Whistler Olympic Park on December 30th. The unseasonable mild temperatures and lack of snow this season forced officials to make last-minute modifications to the racecourse. Despite the challenging conditions, 132 participants aged 4 to 63 braved the rain to take part in the classic technique interval start race.

The event was also a qualifier for the Quesnel 2024 BC Winter Games. Twenty-one (21) athletes born in 2009 and 2010 competed for the opportunity to participate in the Games on February 22-25, 2024.
