- **BIB PICK UP SAT** Bibs and transponders can be picked up on February 22 8:00 – 9:30 a.m. in the Technical Building, next to the Stadium area. Bibs will be available for Payak Mini until 12:30. Payak Mini entrants will not be timed.
- **START LISTS**: We recommend that you check the confirmation list for this event to be sure you have registered correctly. Start lists will be available from the Race Office on the day of the event and posted online on Zone4 on Friday, February 21.
- **FOOD / WATER**: For races of 15 km or more, there will be feed stations. Please see course maps. There will be a feed station in the stadium area, as well as on course.
- **CUT-OFF TIME**: All skiers not reaching the 25 km point (stadium lap) in the 50 km event within 2.5 hours (12:30 pm) will not be allowed to continue.
- **RESULTS**: Unofficial results will be posted outside the Race Office after the race. Unofficial live results are available on Zone4. Results are not final until reviewed by the race jury.
- AWARDS: Awards will be presented at the venue at the conclusion of the races.
