CANADA WINTER **GAMES SELECTION**

SELECTION CRITERIA: 2023 CANADA WINTER GAMES

To be eligible for selection to the BC Team for Canada Winter Games, athletes need

to register in the following categories. Saturday, Jan. 7 - Sprint Classic - U20 Men

U20 Women

Sunday, Jan. 8 - Interval Start Free - U18 Boys, U20 Men

U16 Girls, U18 Girls, U20 Women

Para Stand and Sit: Sunday, Jan. 8 - Distance - Para Sit Men and Para Stand Men

Para Sit Women and Para Stand Women

Para Sit and Stand date of birth 1993 or later

Note: You must indicate in the zone4 registration if you wish to be considered

for selection to the BC Canada Games Team.

CANCELLATION Any advance cancellation of the event will be by Cross Country BC in consultation with the organizing committee and the Technical Delegate.

> A decision to cancel one or more days of competition, or races for specific age categories due to the race conditions during an event will be made by the Technical Delegate in consultation with the Jury.

REFUND **POLICY**

In the occurrence of cancellation by race organizers, a refund of registration fees less administration and event expenses already incurred will be provided post-event. No refunds will be made if an athlete does not participate in race(s).

ZONE4 online booking fees are non-refundable.

LICENSES

All competitors registered in **U14 to Senior categories** must have a current race licence. The following licences are acceptable:

- Nordig Canada Licence
- FIS Licence

- Other National Ski Licence
- Supporting Member Day Licence (SMDL)

SEEDING

Seeding will be used for all age categories except Masters' categories and U12 Boy/Girl and younger categories. If two or more age categories of the same gender are skiing a common distance (for example, U18 Boys and U20 Men) they will be seeded together using the current Canada Points List. These categories will be combined for the start list but separated for results and awards.

START LISTS

Start lists will be posted on zone4.ca by 12:00 PM January 6.

RACE OFFICE

The event race office will be in the WOP technical building by the XC stadium and open from 7:15 am - 4:00 pm.

BIB/CHIP PICKUP

Bibs will not be distributed to clubs or teams. Bibs will be picked up by individual athletes when they pick up their timing chips on the way to the start area. Bibs not picked up will be marked as DNS.

CONCESSION

A cafe at WOP Day Lodge offers food and beverages.

FACILITIES

A ski lodge and washrooms are located in Whistler Olympic Park. Refer to <u>WOP's</u> Conditions webpage for updated facilities information

PARKING

Please park in the designated lots as directed by WOP staff upon arrival.

TRAIL FEES

All vehicles must stop at the gate on arrival. If you arrive and the gate is closed, please park in a line outside the inbound gate. Please do not park in front of the outbound gate or attempt to follow vehicles into the park through the outbound gate. Once the inbound gate is open, proceed to one of the two gate houses to scan season passes or purchase day tickets. Multi-day event tickets will be issued to registered athletes, coaches, and team staff. These will be available for pick up at the main gate house as of January 6, valid for park entry January 6 – 8, 2023. If visiting the venue prior to January 6, all visitors must purchase tickets online or in person. Tickets & Passes | Whistler Olympic Park

Please be aware of gate signage and use the following lanes to scan tickets/passes or to make a purchase.

- Lane 1 (main gate house left side): Scan only (includes season passes and pre-purchased ticket barcodes)
- Lane 2 (main gate house right side): Pay & Scan (season passes, pre-purchased barcodes, and day-of purchases)
- Lane 3 (secondary gate house): Pay & Scan (season passes, pre-purchased tickets, and day-of purchases)

Parents/guardians dropping participants off must also purchase a day ticket (online or in person) or present a season pass <u>if they plan to ski or snowshoe.</u>

Gate access times to be confirmed prior to the event.

WAX FACILITIES

Waxing cabins are available for rent at Whistler Olympic Park at a rate of \$40 per day. Please contact the **Race Office** for wax cabin requests.

WAX TESTING

A wax testing/warm up area will be provided near the cross-country stadium. Wax testing on course will be at the discretion of the Jury. Please refer to BCC 1 event page for maps outlining the testing area.

WAX PROTOCOL

Please see: **CCBC Protocol Regarding the Use of Fluorinated Waxes**

Non-fluoro waxing protocol applies to all ages for BC Cup #1:

- Structure tools ARE permitted.
- Fluoro kick waxes ARE permitted (but not fluoro grip powders).
- Identified non-fluoro (NF) glide waxes ARE permitted

Adherence to this protocol is the responsibility of coaches, parents and wax technicians.
