Registrants are responsible for checking the Zone4 confirmation list.</p> <p>Coaches are required to register at <a href="#">Zone4</a>. Volunteers are required to arrive by 8 am. No fees will be charged.</p> <p>If you experience any difficulties or have questions about registration, please contact the Race Secretary.</p>	
<b>RACE ENTRY DEADLINE</b>	<p>Race entry deadline is <b>Tuesday, February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at Midnight PST</b></p> <p>Late entries will be accepted until Wednesday February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at midnight PST and will be subject to a \$30.00 per race late entry fee. Late entries will not be seeded. Please contact Race Secretary for assistance as the web registration will be closed.</p>	
<b>CANCELLATIONS</b>	Any advance cancellation of the event will be by Cross Country BC in consultation with the organizing committee and the Technical Delegate. A decision to cancel one day of competition or cancel races for specific age categories due to the snow or weather conditions during an event will be made by the Jury.	

<b>REFUNDS</b>	<p>In the event of cancellation by race organizers, a refund of registration fees less administration, Zone4 online booking fees and event expenses already incurred will be provide post-event.</p> <p>No refunds will be provided if an athlete does not participate in a race.</p>												
<b>LICENCES</b>	<p>All competitors skiing in <b>U14 to Master</b> categories must have a current race licence. The following licences are acceptable: Nordiq Canada Licence, FIS Licence, Other National Ski Licence or Nordiq Canada Tier 3 Event Licence.</p> <p>Competitors in <b>U12 and younger</b> categories do not need a license to compete.</p>												
<b>SEEDING:</b>	<p>The most current Canada Points List will be used for the draw for all categories except Masters and U12 and younger whereby the leading points holder will have the first position in the start grid/chevron. If two or more age categories of the same gender are skiing a common distance, they will be seeded together using the current Canada Points List. These categories will be combined for the start list but will be separated for results and awards.</p> <p>For competitors in Masters category and U12 and younger categories will be grouped together by their age/gender category and the start order will be determined by a random draw. If any of these categories has large numbers of entries the race organizing committee and the Technical Delegate may, at their discretion, separate the category into the 2 distinct year of birth categories and use a random draw to determine the order of start.</p>												
<b>START LISTS</b>	<p>Start lists will be posted in the breezeway and on Zone4 by 12:00 pm on Feb. 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024.</p>												
<b>COURSE MAPS</b>	<p>Course maps are available <a href="#">here</a>. Courses are subject to change in response to low snow conditions.</p>												
<b>RACE OFFICE</b>	<p>The race office is located in the technical building by the XC stadium. It will be open from 7:15-16:00 on race days and at 10:00-16:00 on the training day.</p>												
<b>BIB &amp; CHIP PICKUP</b>	<p><b>Bibs and timing chips will be picked up by each athlete on the way to the start area.</b></p> <p>Bibs not picked up will be marked as DNS.</p>

All vehicles must stop at the gate on arrival. If you arrive and the gate is closed, please park in a line outside the inbound gate. Please do not park in front of the outbound gate or attempt to follow vehicles into the park through the outbound gate.</p>	
<b>WAX CABINS</b>	Wax cabins are available for rent for \$50.00 per day. Contact the Competition Secretary for wax cabin requests.	
<b>WAX TESTING</b>	A wax testing/warm up area will be designated near the cross-country stadium. Wax testing on course will be at the discretion of the jury. A wax testing map is available on the event webpage.
