Eligibility:

Canadians or Canadian residents must have a valid and active membership with the Canadian Masters Cross Country Ski Association in order to participate in the 2015 Masters National Championships. Memberships may be purchased through your provincial director at http://www.canadian-masters-xc-ski.ca or will also be available for purchase on Zone4 through the online registration page for this event. U.S. citizens who are not residents of Canada may participate without MCC membership, but are not eligible for MCC awards (alternative awards are provided for American winners).

Waivers:

All participants will be required to sign a digital waiver when registering online for the event. Participants will not be permitted to race without having signed the waiver.

Race Entry Fees and Deadlines:

\$30 per race for all age categories (EARLY BIRD RATE before 24 January at midnight PST) \$45 per race for all age categories from 25 January to 2 February at midnight PST \$50 per race for all age categories from 3 February to 7 February 2015 at 18:00 PST

Final deadline for online registration is 7 February at 18:00 PST

All entry fees include lunch on the day of the race Evening Pasta dinner (Tuesday, 10 February): \$20.00 Tall Tales and Tapas social event (Thursday 12 February): \$25.00 Banquet (Saturday, 14 February): \$45.00

How to Enter:

Registration will be online from the 2015 Masters Cross Country National Championships website: www.2015crosscountryskimasters.ca (where you will find a link to registration via Zone4) from 1 December 2014. Payment must be made at the time of registration. (Note that Zone 4 supports Visa or Mastercard only). Please check the Zone4 confirmation list for this race to be sure that you have registered correctly (and inform the Race Secretary, Nancy Flood:nflood@tru.ca of any errors) Tickets for the social events, as well as for the MCC ski draw, can be purchased online when registering. Limited tickets for these events will be available at the site, depending on availability.

Facilities

A heated day lodge and outhouses, as well as flush toilets, are located near the parking area at the start of the Stake lake trail system, which is approximately 800 m from the stadium. The machine shop will be cleared and used as a warming room/lodge for weekend. Portable toilets are available near the stadium and outhouses are located at various locations along the trails.

Waxing

Electrical outlets are available adjacent to the stadium. A few outlets are also available outside the Stake Lake day lodge (800 m from the stadium). No waxing inside the day lodge. A warm-up and wax testing area is available near the stadium; **n**o wax testing or warm up is allowed on the course during the competition.
