**Courtenay, BC** – Vancouver Island's Mount Washington Skiing Alpine Resort was the location of another successful Teck Regional Fall Dryland Camp on September 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>. 49 athletes and 9 coaches participated, with representation from across the island, Victoria to Campbell River.

Under sunny skies and warm temperatures, the first morning of the camp consisted of a skate roller ski hill climb time trial for older skiers, a double pole roller ski time trial for younger skiers and an introduction to roller skiing for a new group of Track Attackers. It was great to see the enthusiasm and big smiles on those trying roller skiing for the first time. The first day ended with a ski striding technique session, sprint relays and various group games.

With much cooler temperatures and the mountain shrouded in fog on day two, coaches kept athletes active and engaged in a full morning scavenger hunt/adventure run with stations spread over the upper and mid level Nordic trails, which happen to be resplendent in amazing fall colours right now. Fall colour gazing aside, athletes went through a series of strength exercises at each station and collected letters for the word scramble game which was an added element to the activity this year.
