A qualification round (15-second interval start) will be followed by quarter-final and subsequent heats. Heats will be offered for age categories, not YOB. Small categories may be combined. All skiers will be given the opportunity to compete in a minimum of the Qualification Round and one heat. Skiers in the U12 and younger categories will not be seeded for the sprint qualifier but will be grouped according to their category and a normal draw.

	cancel the competition. With any difficult weather conditions (e.g. strong winds, high air humidity, heavy						
	snow, icy track conditions) at any air temperature, the Jury may, on consultation						
	with the Team Leaders of the participating teams and the doctor responsible for the						
	competition, postpone, cancel or shorten the competition.
