Teck BC Cup Brings Provincial Spotlight to Prince George

The Caledonia Nordic Ski Club proudly hosted the 2026 Teck BC Cup #1 on January 10– 11, welcoming over 350 athletes, supported by 70 coaches, along with hundreds of family members and spectators from across British Columbia and beyond.

This marked one of the largest BC Cup cross-country ski events ever hosted in Prince George, with teams travelling from every corner of the province. Visiting clubs included strong contingents from the Okanagan, East and West Kootenays, Vancouver, Vancouver Island, alongside a welcome and exciting appearance by skiers from Whitehorse and Montana. Northern BC clubs were also well represented, including teams from Mackenzie, Vanderhoof, Burns Lake, Smithers, Quesnel, 100 Mile House, and Williams Lake.



Event Highlights

- **Saturday, January 10:** Interval Start Classic Technique races showcased technical precision, and endurance.
- **Sunday, January 11:** Exciting Mass Start Free Technique races delivered fast-paced, head-to-head competition.

The event also featured a large and impressive presence from the UNBC Nordic Ski Team as well as the UBC Nordic Team, adding a strong university racing element and energizing the local atmosphere.

Athletes, coaches, and families repeatedly praised the venue quality, course preparation, and event organization. One parent-coach from Rossland noted that her daughter specifically wanted to race in Prince George because *"it feels like a World Cup event."* The club was blessed with excellent weather, exceptional grooming conditions, and the dedication of a tireless volunteer and staff team, all of which contributed to a seamless and memorable weekend of racing.
