- Licenses:** ALL participants must purchase a Tier 3 Event Licence regardless of whether they hold an FIS Licence, Nordiq Canada Race Licence, Development Licence, or Associate Race Licence. This license will only be valid for the competition day for which it is issued and will automatically be added to all race registrations on Zone4.
- Entry Deadline:** Closing deadline for online registration is:  
**Wednesday February 19<sup>th</sup> 11:59 pm 2025**  
**NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**
- Draw:** Start lists will be posted online at: <http://www.100milenordics.com/teck-northerncup> the Friday prior to the race and posted outside the lodge on race morning.
- Bib Pick-up:** Race day: 9 am to 10:30 am outside the ski lodge
- Awards:** Awards for athletes 15 years and younger will be provided by Teck Resources Ltd. Ribbons and medals will be given to participants aged 15 and younger, as follows: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place medals for age categories 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 – both male and female will be awarded. Ribbons for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> place skiers will be provided for the above age categories, as will participant ribbons for all children 7 years of age and younger. Awards for older athletes will be provided by 100 Mile Nordics.
- Waxing:** Plugins are available along the fence by the lodge for waxing gear. Bring your own tent.

- Courses:** Course maps will be posted online as soon as the courses have been finalized. Check the 100 Mile Nordics website [www.100milenordics.com](http://www.100milenordics.com) for the link to the maps.
- Concession:** A hot drink and snack will be provided to participants at the finish line. Otherwise, participants should bring their own drinks, snacks, and lunch. A food concession is available on-site at the day lodge. The lodge has limited capacity. Take-away food options are limited to snacks.
- Accommodation:** For accommodations in the area, please visit [here](#). 100 Mile House is only 5 minutes from the trails.
- Trail Pass:** Registered racers can use trails for the day of the race. Spectators do not require a trail pass to watch the race. Family and coaches of racers from

out of the 100 Mile House area can request complimentary trail passes for the day of the race.

**Cancellation:** Participants who choose not to start their race will not receive a refund. However, if race organizers cancel the race due to unsafe weather conditions, participants will receive a full refund, except for any online processing fees. Races will also be cancelled or postponed if the temperature or weather conditions are unsuitable at the start time.

With air temperatures below -20°C (temperature measured at the coldest point of the course and without wind factor) and competition distances less than or equal to 15 km, the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition. The Jury must postpone or cancel the competition for U10 and younger, with air temperatures below -15°C (temperature measured at the coldest part of the course and without a wind factor).

**Race Routes:** Route maps will be posted outside the lodge before the race and on the 100 Mile Nordics website.
