

Nechako Nordics Host Final in Teck Northern Cup Series

The final in the Teck Northern Cup Series was hosted by the Nechako Nordics on the unceded ancestral territory of the Saik'uz First Nation. 122 skiers took part in the interval start free technique race on a beautiful sunny day with temperatures reaching -4 C and great snow conditions. Northern clubs that were represented included: Cariboo Ski Touring club (Quesnel), Caledonia Nordic Ski Club (Prince George), Omineca Ski Club (Burns Lake), Morice Mountain Nordic Ski Club (Houston), Bulkley Valley Cross Country Ski Club (Smithers), and the Nechako Nordics Ski Club (Vanderhoof).

For many young skiers this was an introduction to participating in an organized race event. As well, some young skiers used this as a tune up leading up to the BC Winter games or Teck BC Championships. Spectators were in abundance as they cheered on both novice and experienced skiers.
