Accommodation:

Accommodations are available in the Village of Burns Lake.

Trail pass:

Registered racers can use trails for the day of the race. Spectators do not require a trail pass to watch the race. Family and coaches of racers from out of the Burns Lake area can request complimentary trail passes for the day of the race.

Cancellation:

There will be no refund for participants who choose to not start their race. If race organizers cancel the race(s) due to unsafe weather conditions, a full refund will be made to participants except for any online processing fees. Races will be cancelled or postponed if temperature or weather conditions are unsuitable at start time.

With air temperatures below -20°C (temperature measured at the coldest point of the course and without wind factor) and competition distances less than or equal to 15 km, the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition. For athletes under 12 years of age, with air temperatures below -15C (temperature measured at the coldest part of the course and without a wind factor), the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition.
