

## **Nechako Nordics Host Final in Teck Northern Cup Series 2025**


On March 8<sup>th</sup> the final ski race in the Teck Northern Cup Series took place in the geographical centre of British Columbia, Vanderhoof. The snow held up and 100 skiers from seven clubs across the north and northwest experienced early spring skiing conditions in plus 5 temperatures. Ski clubs that were represented included Cariboo Ski Touring Club (Quesnel), Caledonia Nordic Ski Club (Prince George), Mackenzie Nordiques, Omineca Ski Club (Burns Lake), Morice Mountain Nordic Ski Club (Houston), Bulkley Valley Cross Country Ski Club (Smithers), and the host Nechako Nordics (Vanderhoof).

The Free Technique, Interval Start event had both experienced and competitive skiers tuning up for the National Championships, and skiers who were participating for the joy of skiing, personal goals, or to gain experience. The U8's started the races off with many cheers from spectators.
