The Hollyburn Cross Country Ski Club took home the top aggregate prize with the host club, Telemark Nordic coming in second place.



A few young athletes from the 100 Mile Nordics Ski Team shared their excitement about the event. One racer said, "I loved racing at the Teck BC Track Attack Race. It was my first time skiing at Telemark, and I loved the trails because they go up and down and that made it really fun! We also got to dress up and race, which was awesome.
